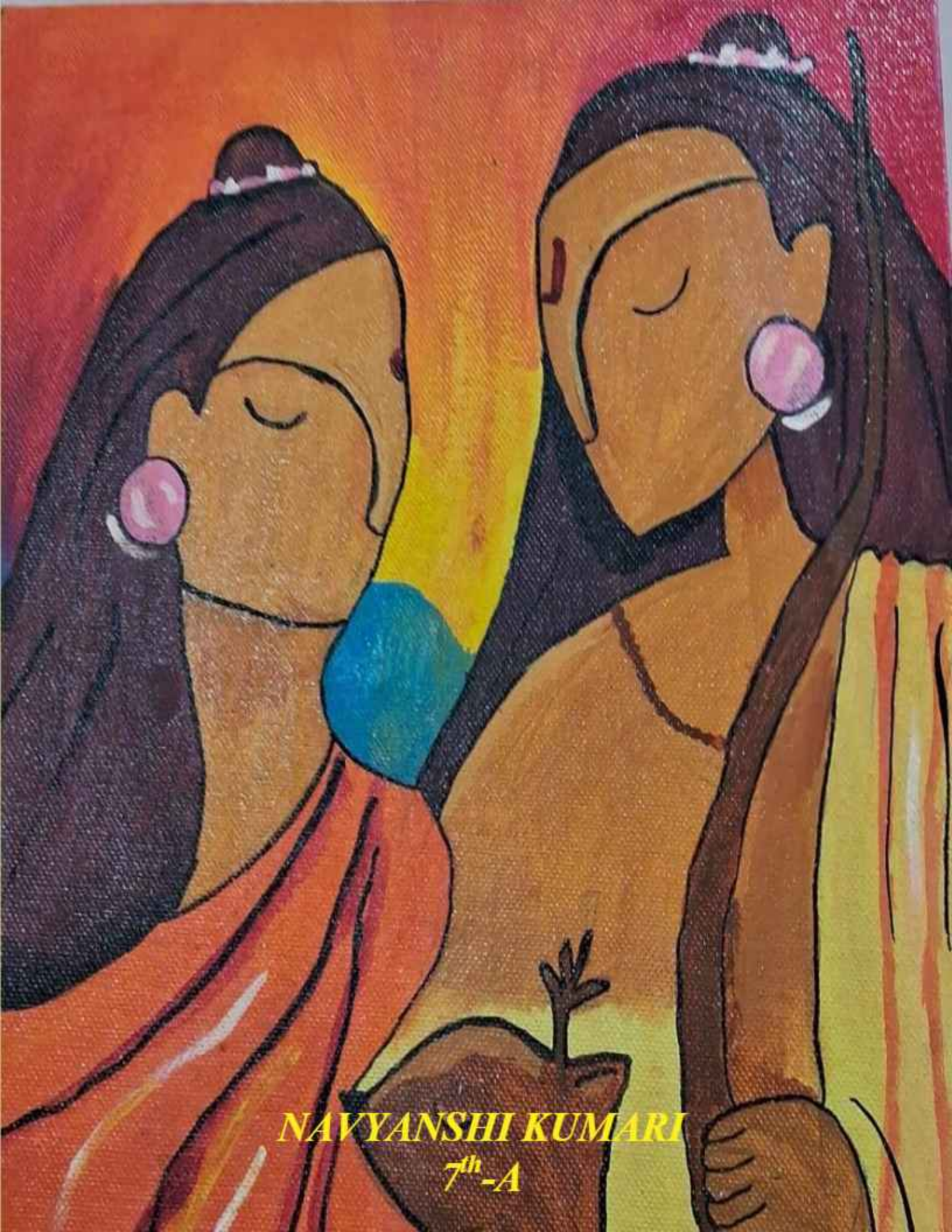

Congratulations students! May your journey ahead be filled with success, happiness, and the same spirit of determination that you've exhibited during your time with us.

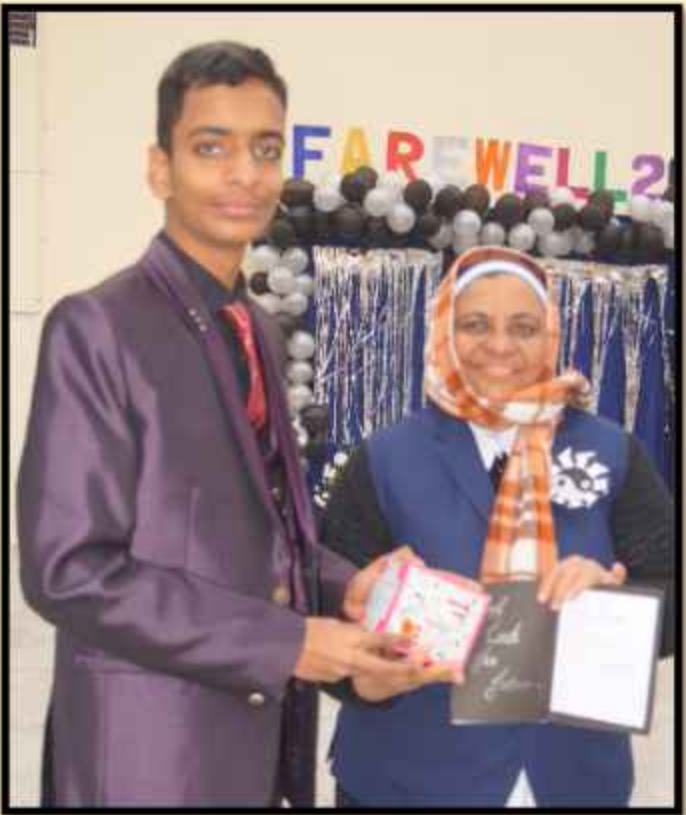

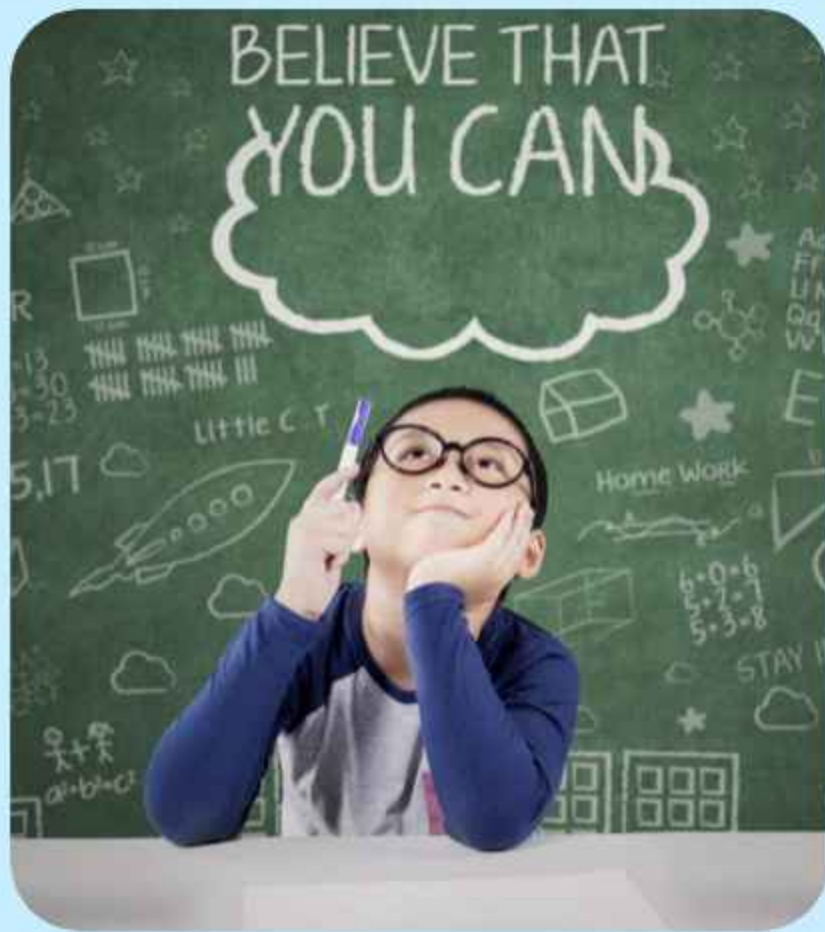
