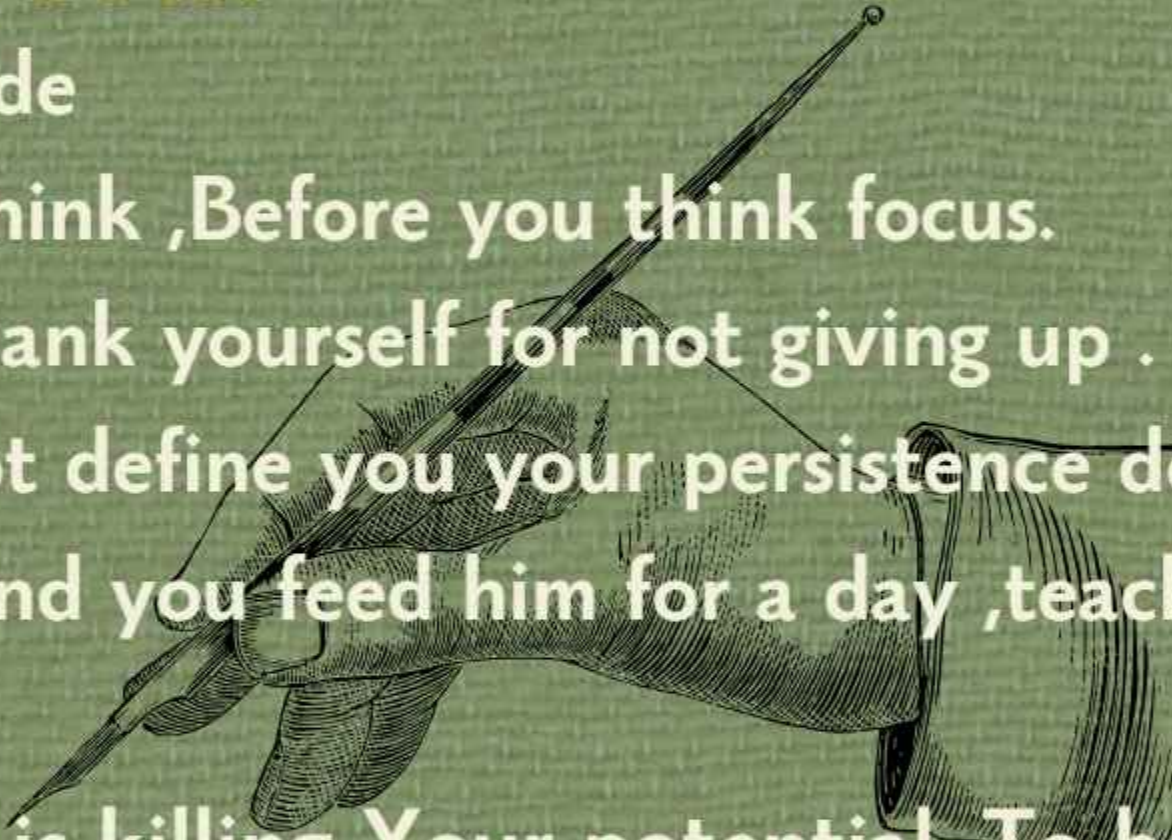

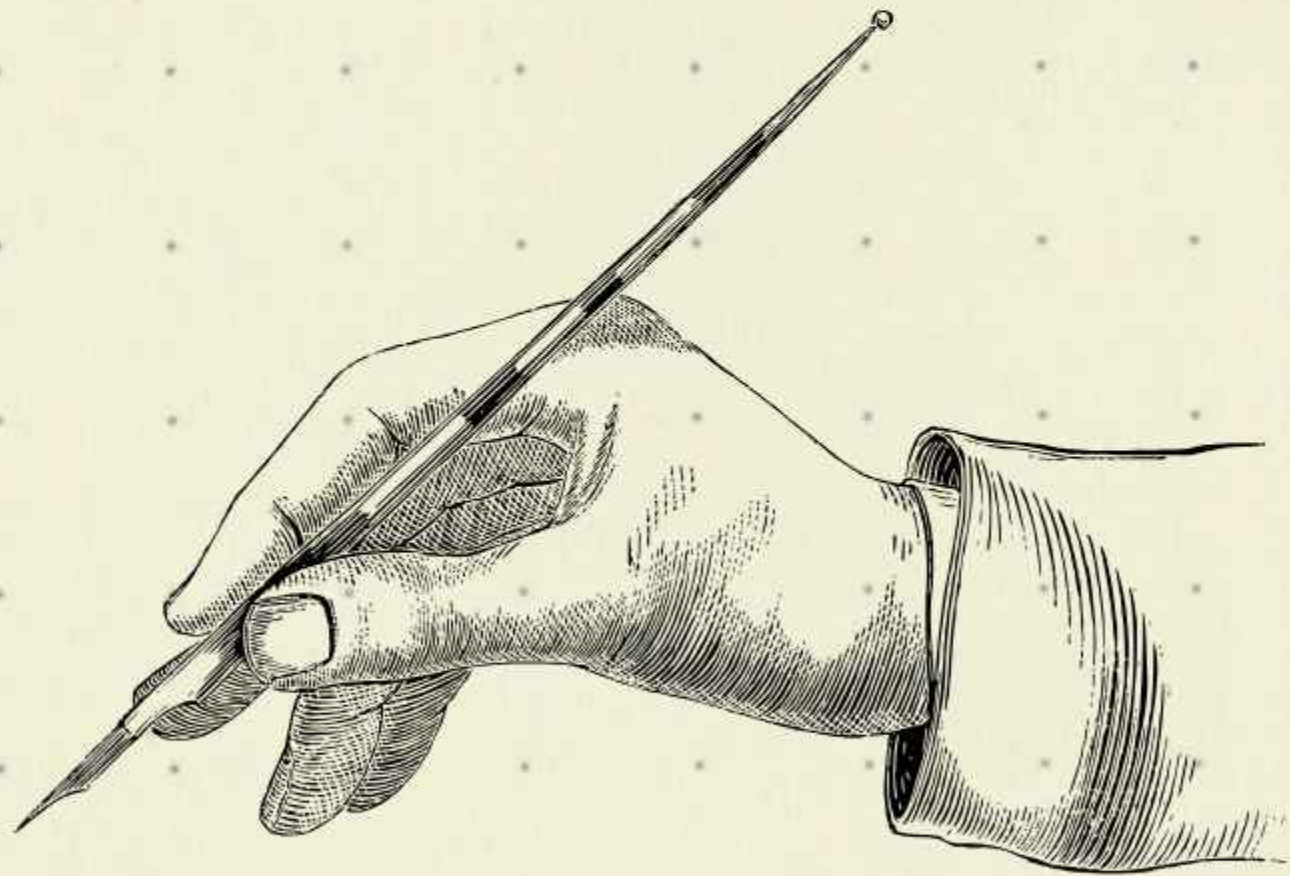

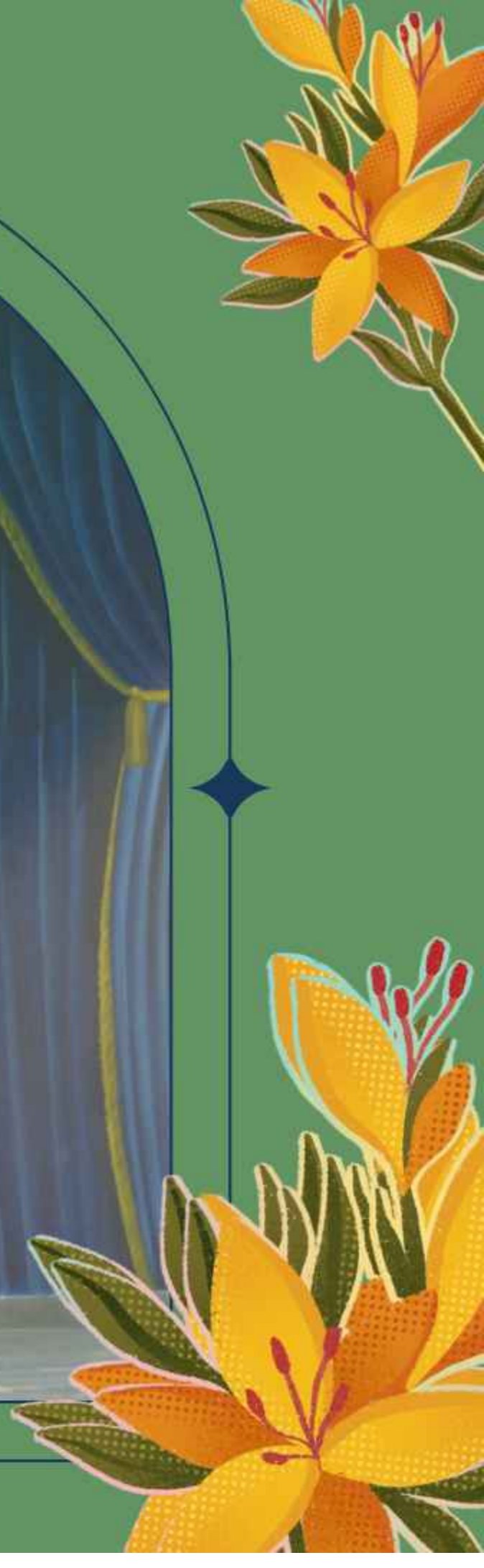
Our school community proudly celebrated the feast of Mother Veronica, our revered founder/spiritual guide. The special assembly feature was:

- Tribute to Mother Veronica's legacy















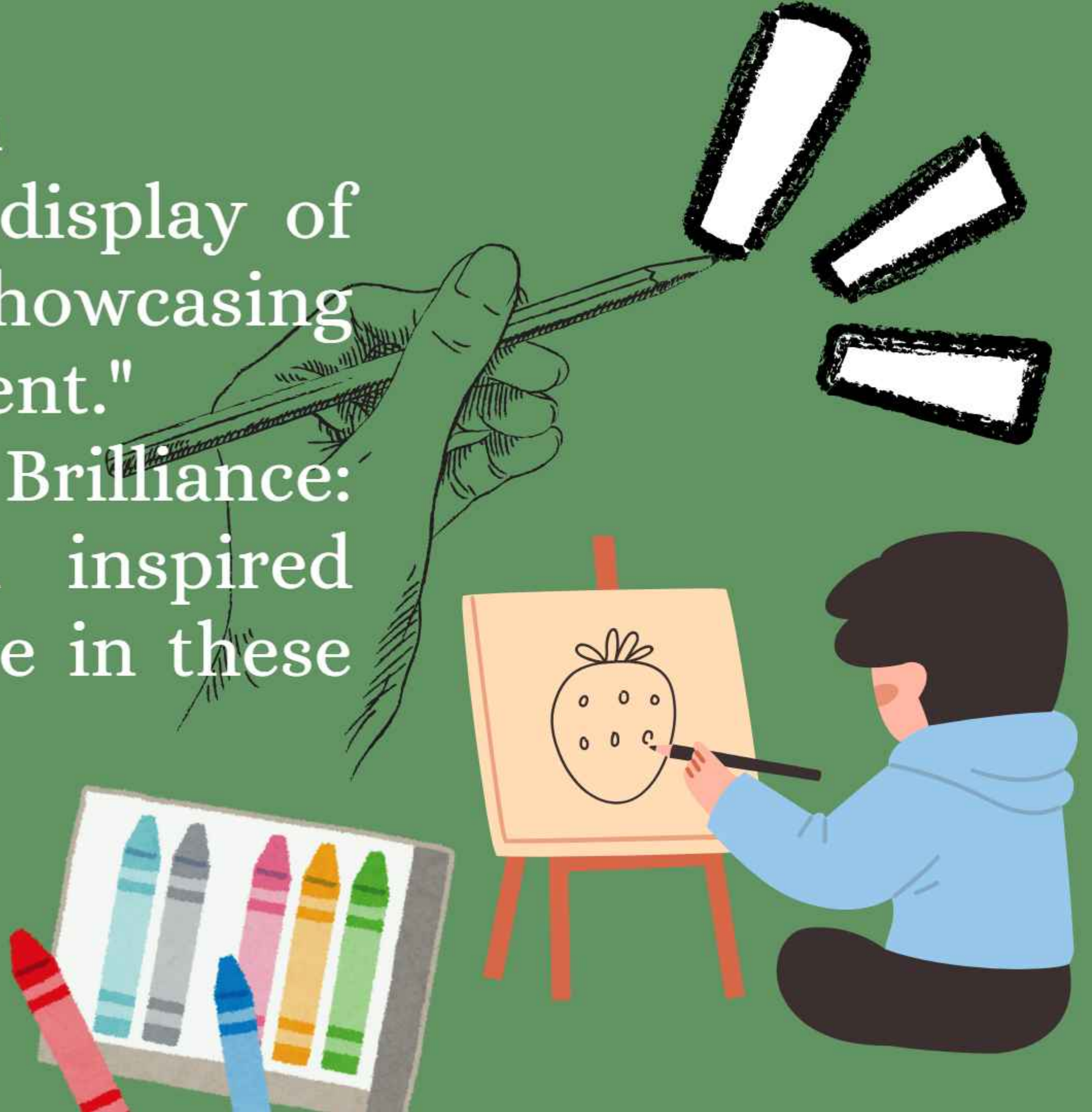


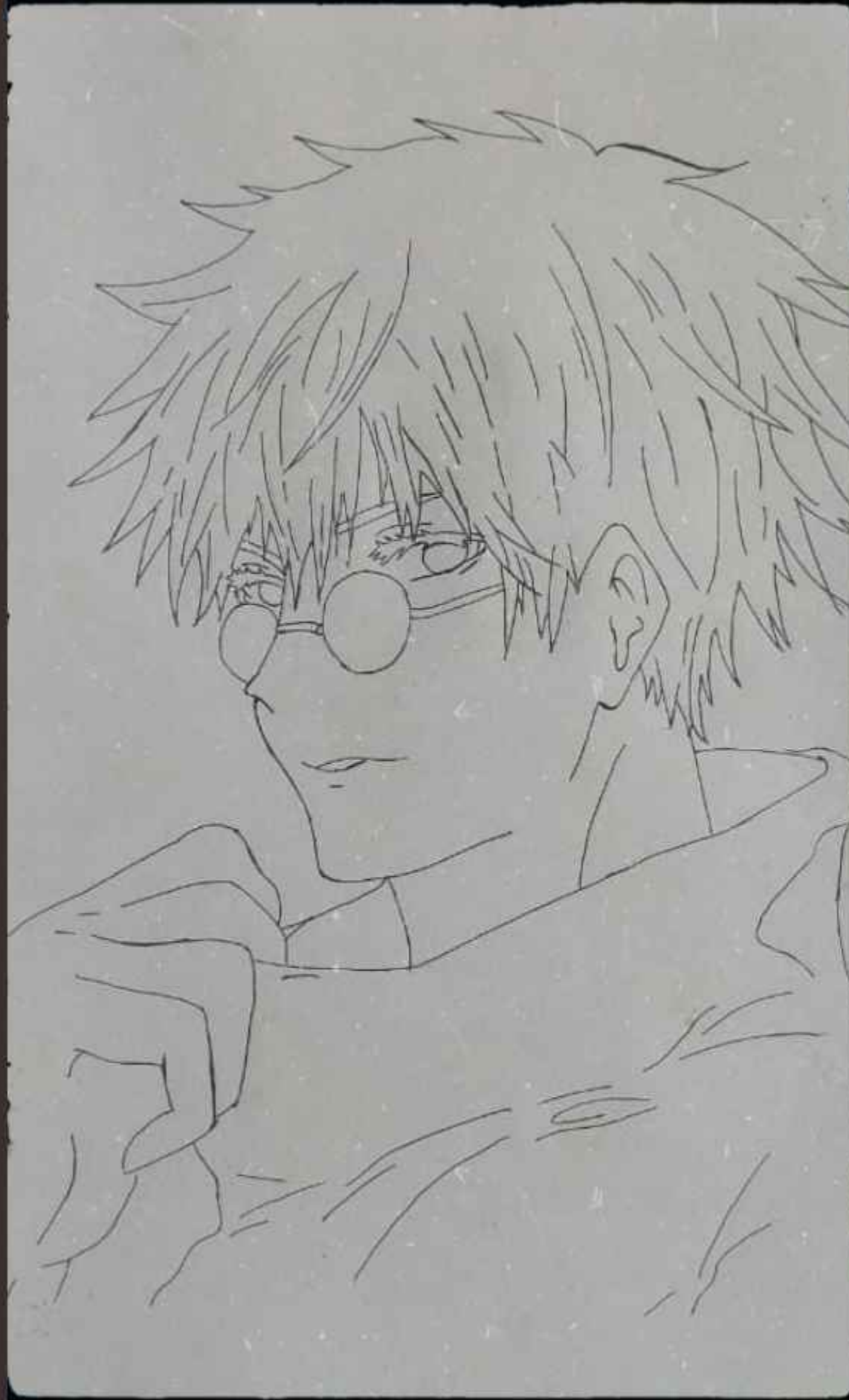




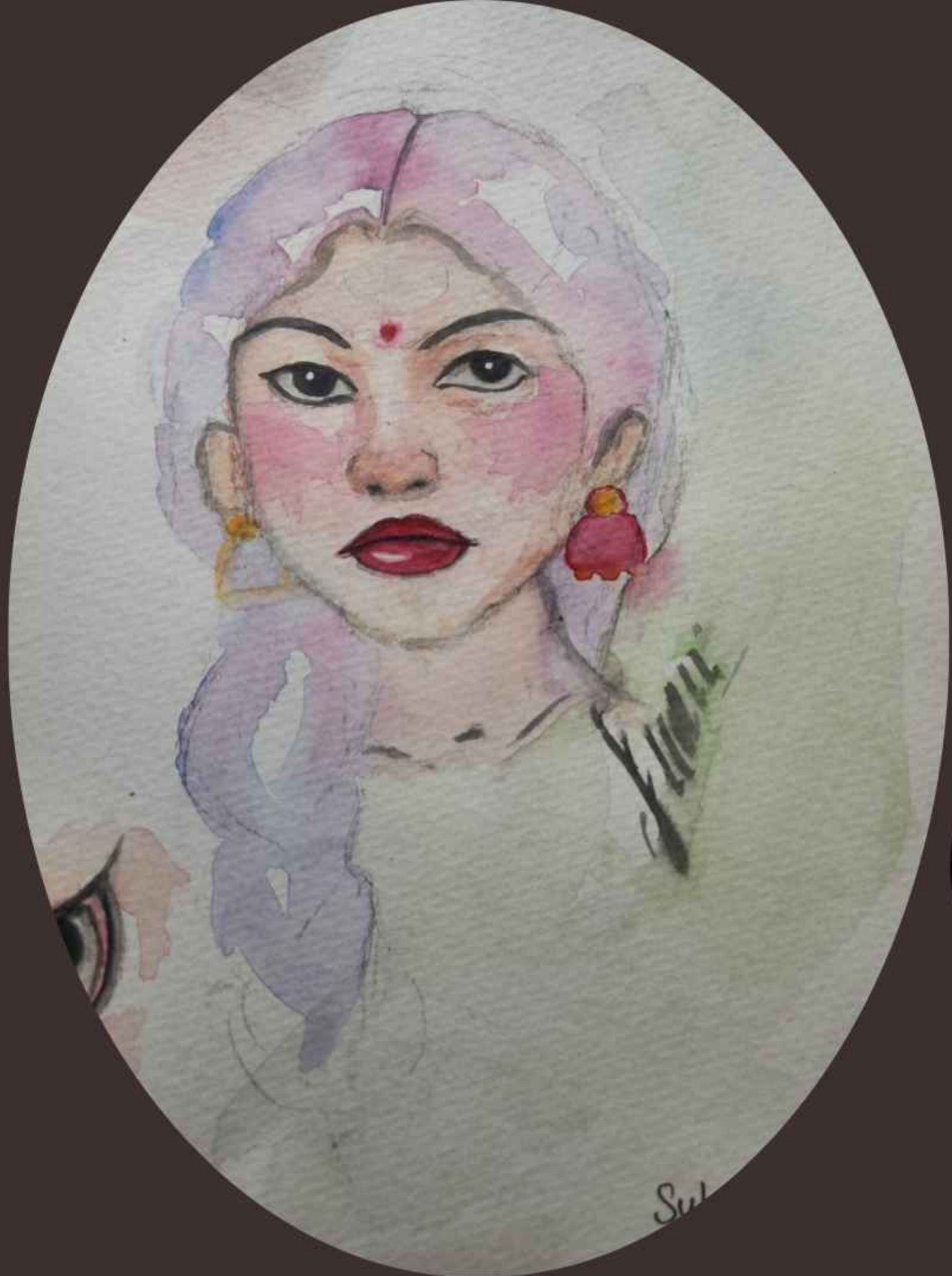
