
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

The Power of Perseverance


Dear Students and Teachers,

10,000 ways that won't work."



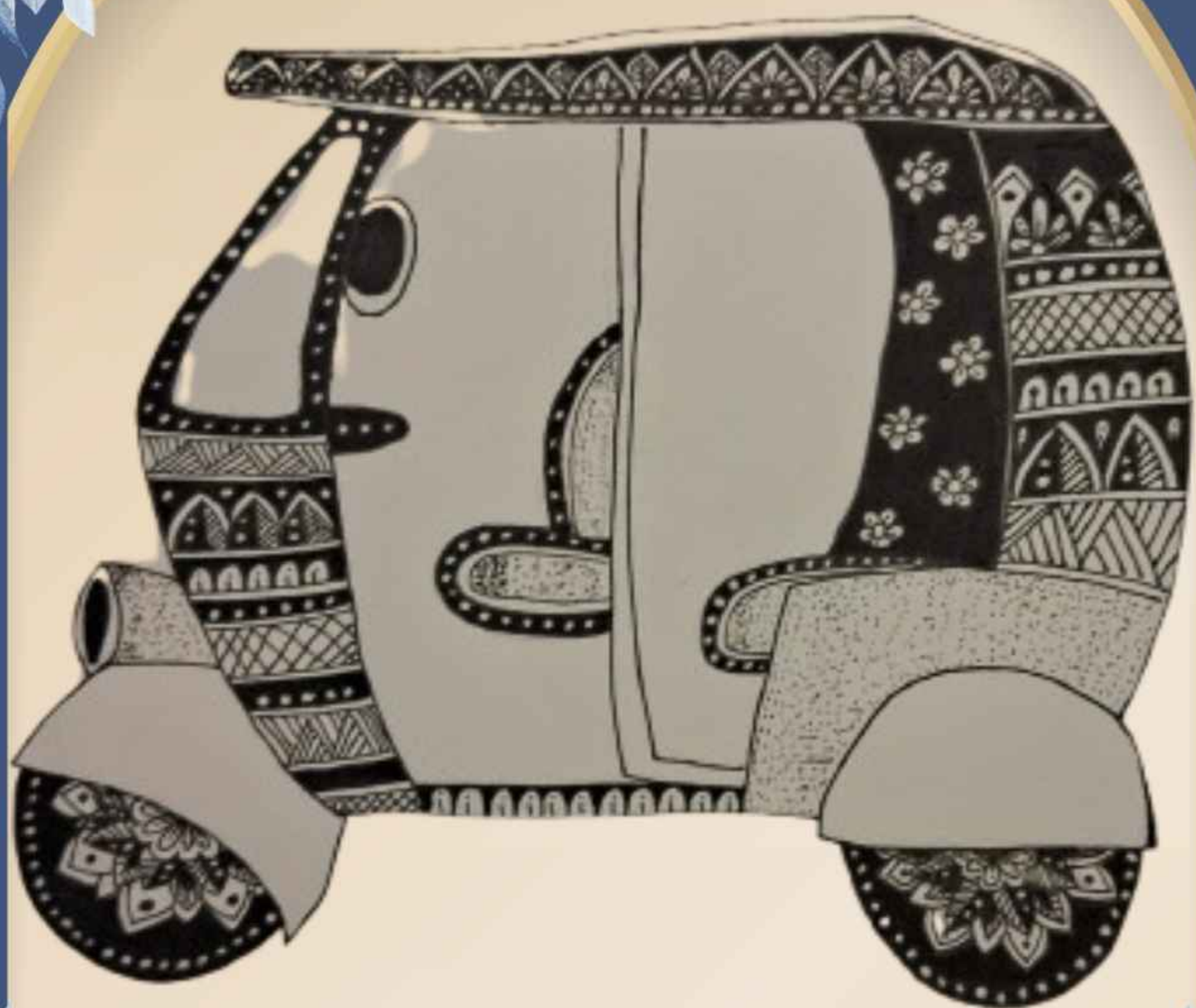
"Imagination Unleashed!"

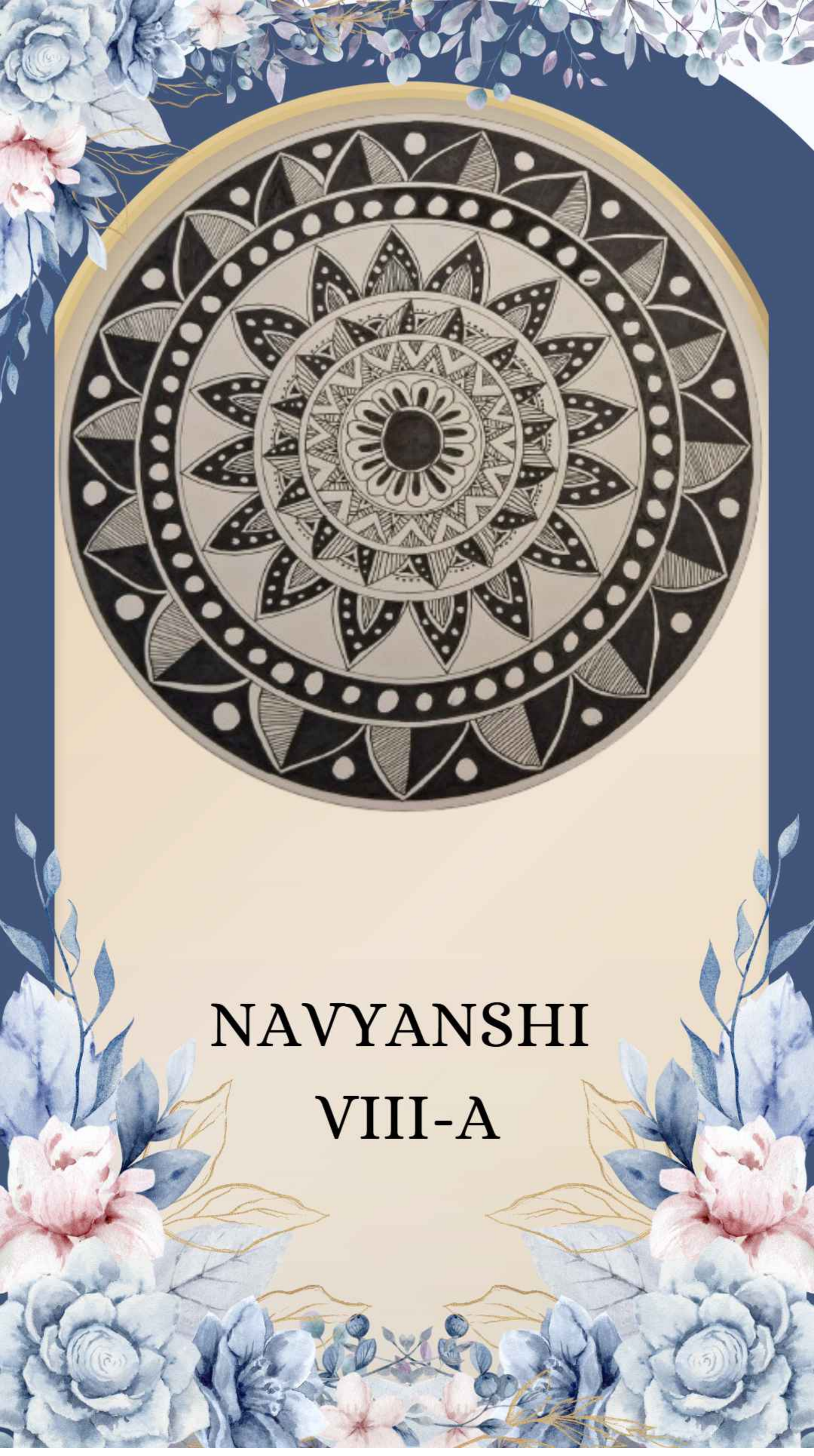

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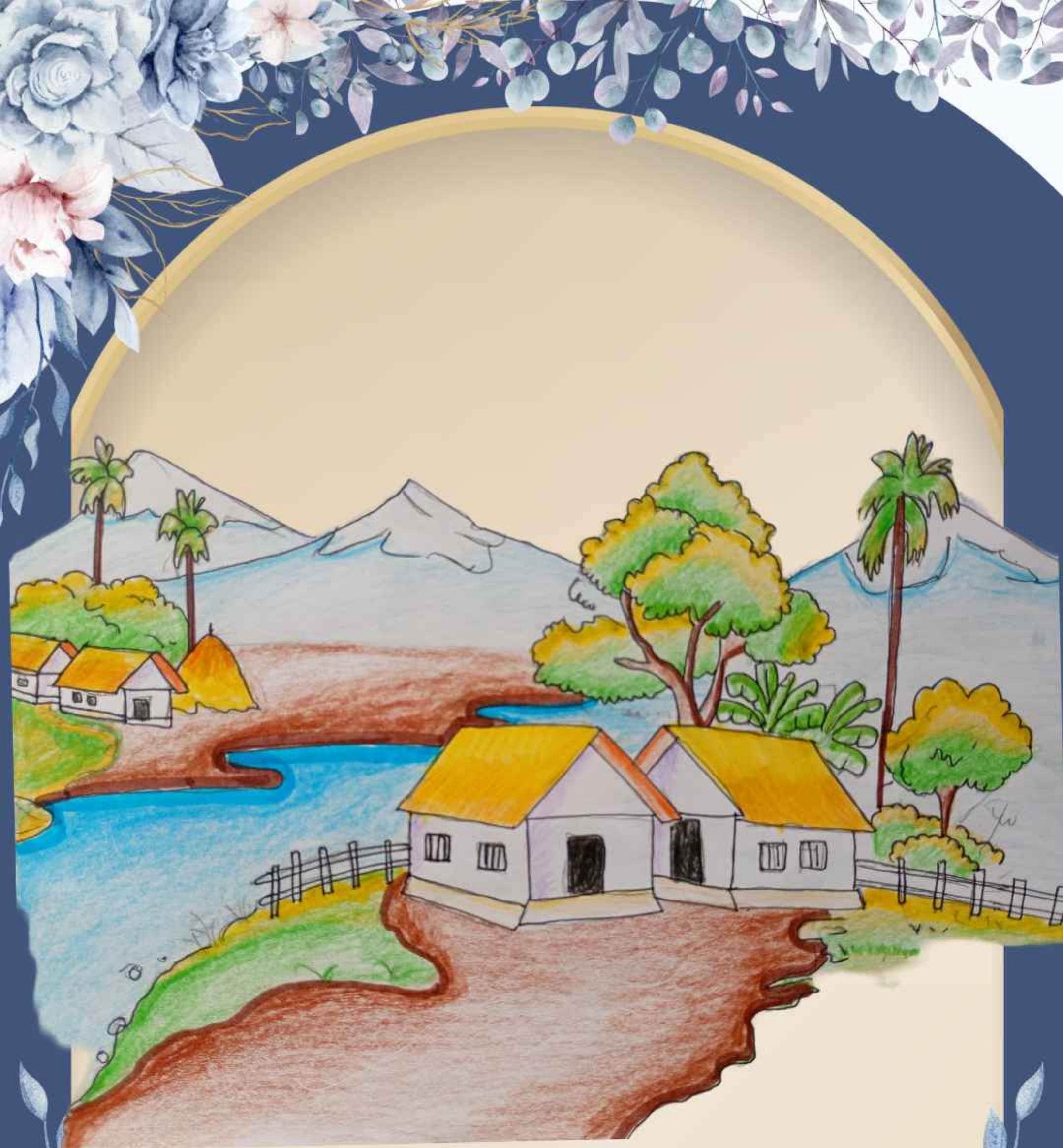

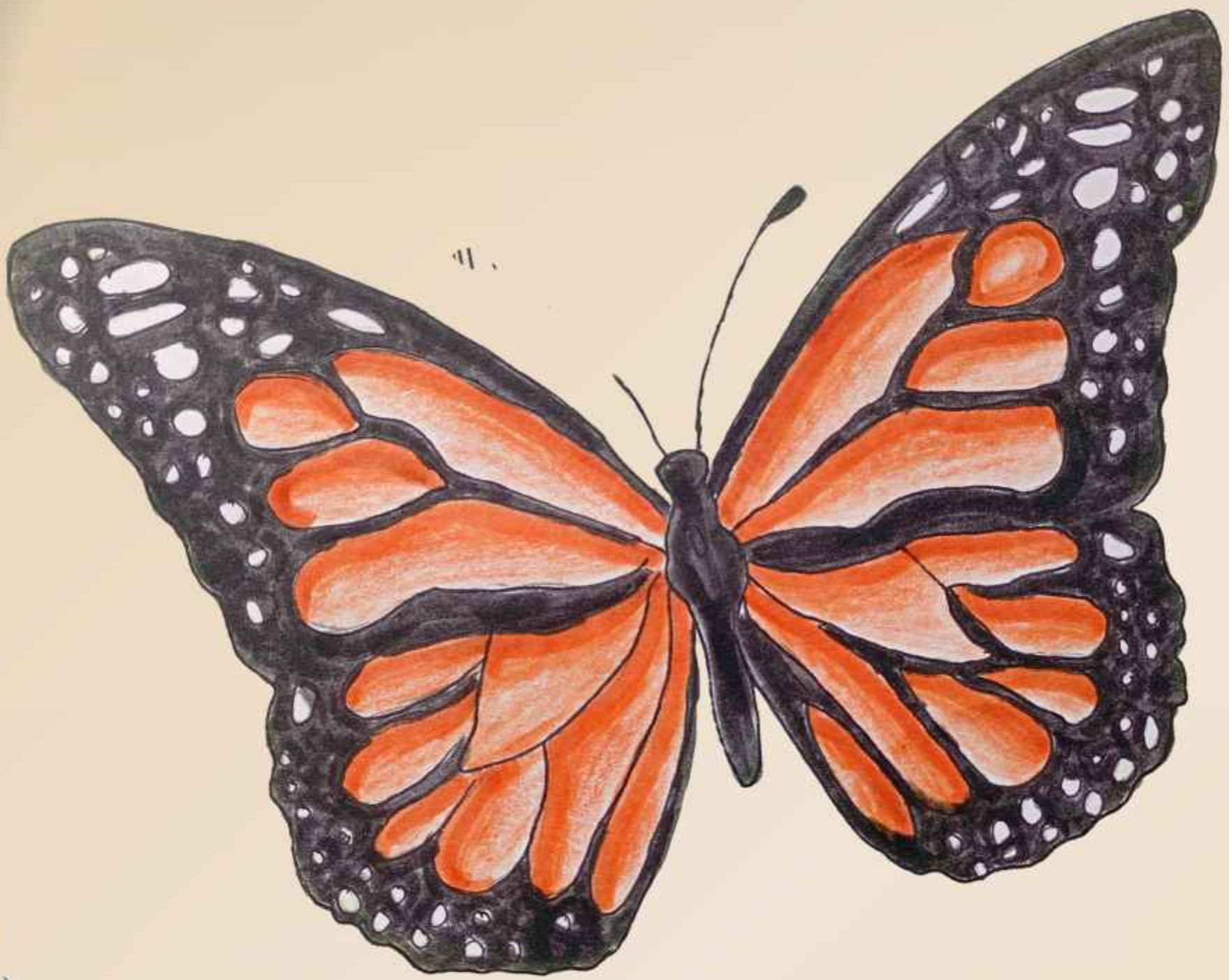
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"Creative Minds Shine!
