
SELF-DISCIPLINE: THE KEY TO SUCCESS

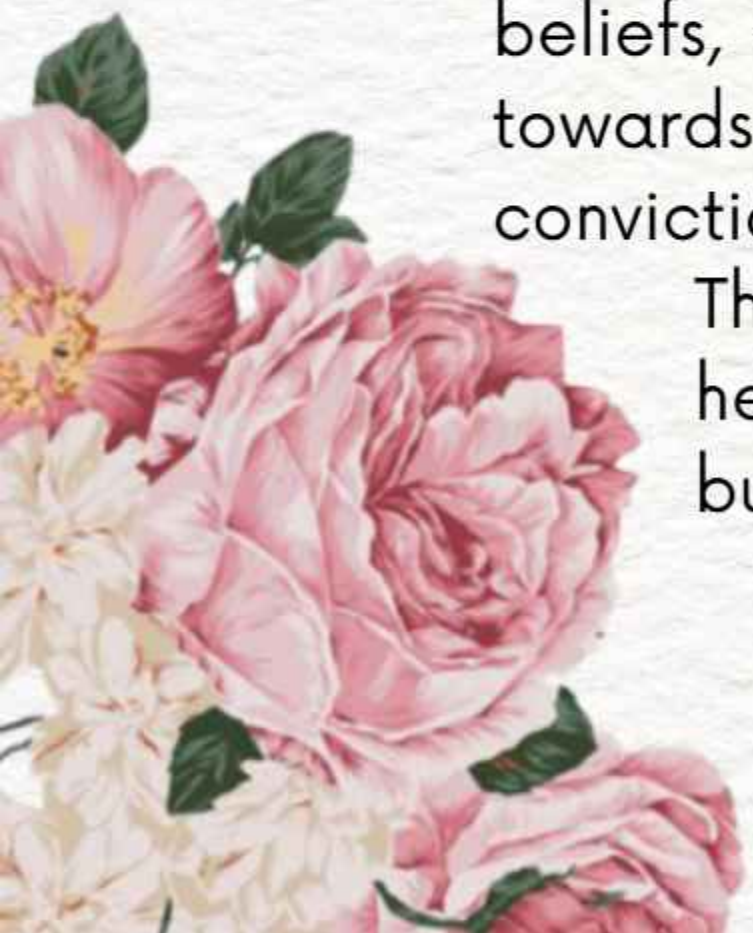
"St. Maria Goretti Day: A Celebration of Faith and Courage"

The program covered a range of topics, including:

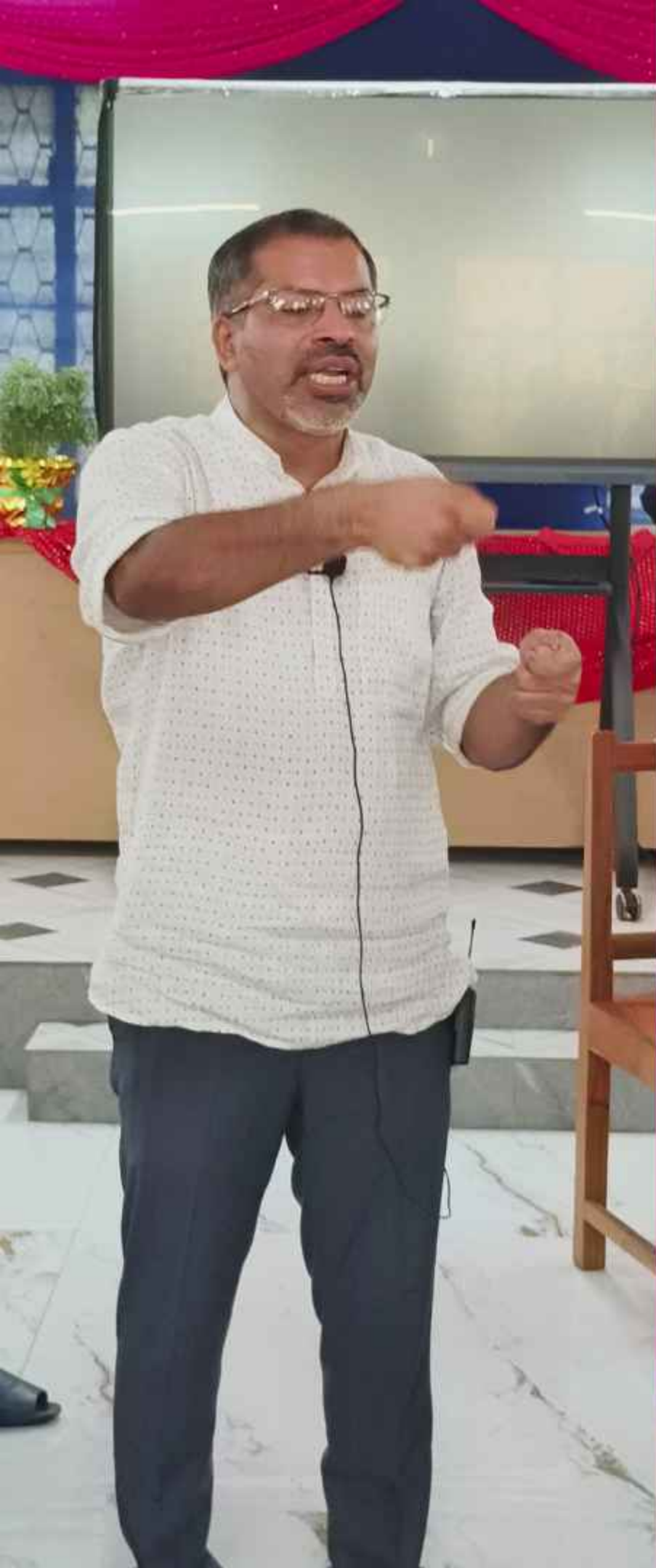

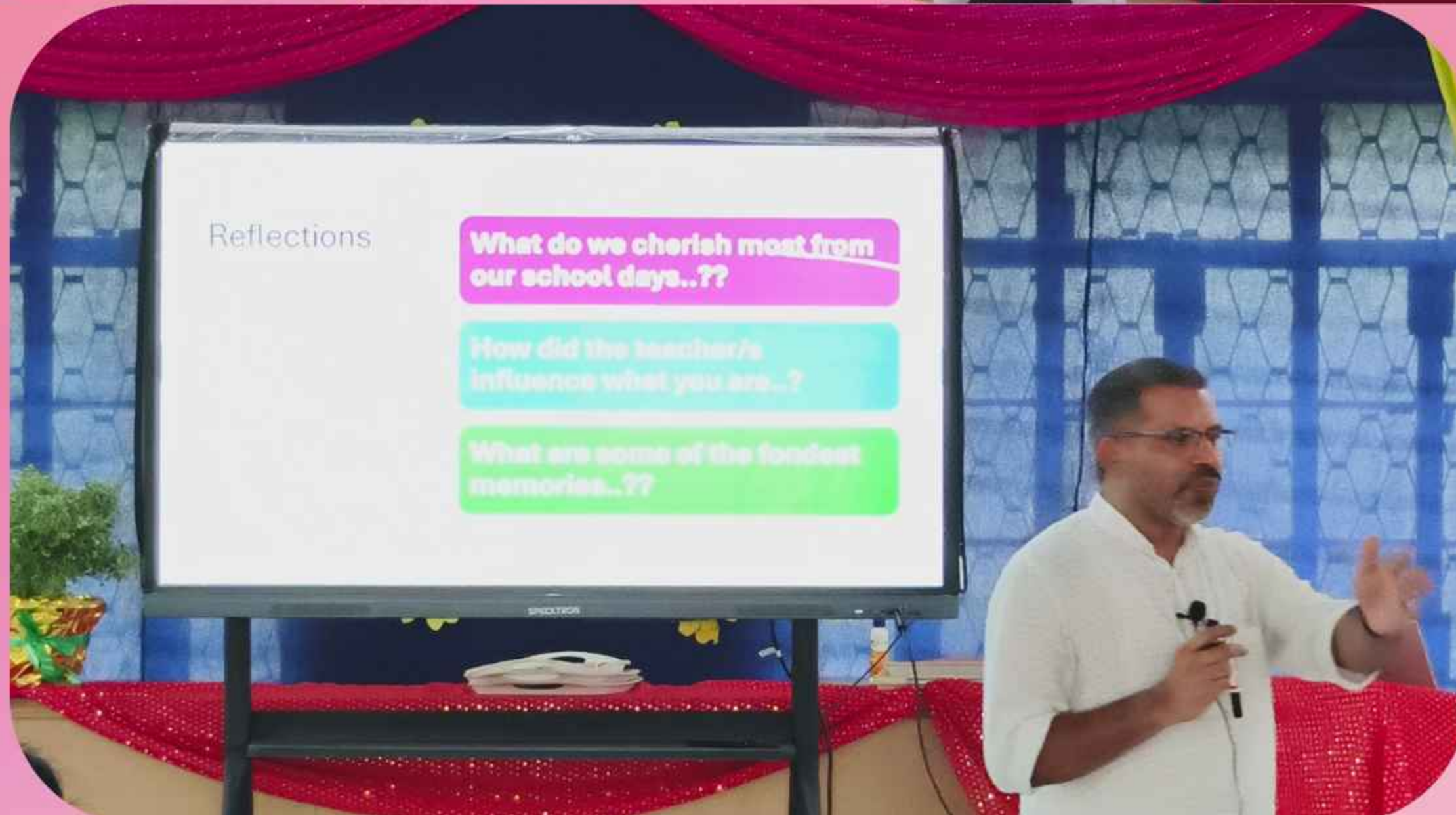
